- All the papers will be evaluated by a technical review committee through a fair and rigorous peer review procedure to guarantee a conference of the highest quality. All accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings and scheduled for presentation only on the condition that the author(s) personally will be making the presentation at the Conference.
